Core Policy Components

- Define acceptable AI use across roles
- ☐ Identify approved AI tools for business use
- ☐ Ensure data privacy policies apply to Al input/output

Risk Awareness

- Train staff on prompt hygiene (no sensitive data)
- ☐ Monitor for unapproved tools (Shadow AI)
- Outline basic red flags for AI misuse

Governance & Oversight

- Assign Al policy owner
- ☐ Create basic reporting process for concerns
- Set review timeline (e.g. quarterly)

Encourage Smart Adoption

- ☐ Encourage team experimentation with guardrails
- ☐ Include AI in existing tech onboarding & security briefings
- Make it easy for teams to suggest tools for approval
